## French Language ARts

We have been learning different reading strategies from
Charlotte la Chenille (Charlotte the Caterpillar) and we have been using these when we get to words we don't know. Ask you child to teach your these strategies during your home reading time.

We continue to look at addition and we will also be learning about subtraction this month. We will study the relationship between addition and subtraction.

Ask your child to show you the different ways to solve and addition or subtraction problem.

We will also begin looking at estimation and how to estimate a quantity using a referent.


We have finished learning about our five senses. There were many fun experiments and we learned a lot! We are now focusing on the seasonal changes of spring.
