

## The Spiral of Success: Contributing

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Our topic for this week is "contributing". Kelly and her companions go in search of the **Lame One**, who can tell them how to find the last piece of the **Spiral of Success**. They find the **Lame One**, whom they discover is skilful at staff fighting; he tells them that the piece they need is just on the other side of the bridge. Unfortunately, the bridge is guarded by the **Dark Knight**. The **Lame One** is the only one who can defeat the **Dark Knight**, but the **Lame One** can't walk, and his horse won't go on the bridge. The group suggests a plan in which the **Bright Knight** will act as the **Lame One's** horse and carry the **Lame One** on his back. The fighting begins and the **Lame One's** staff is knocked into the water. Kelly directs **Beaver** to swim to the staff. Then **Ted Bear** climbs on the rocks to get it and give it to **Rabbit**, who runs the fastest, to return it to the **Lame One**. He then defeats the **Dark Knight**, whom they discover is really **Zor**. The group renames the **Lame One** the **Able one**. The prized piece of the spiral is secured and on it is written: "Contributing".
