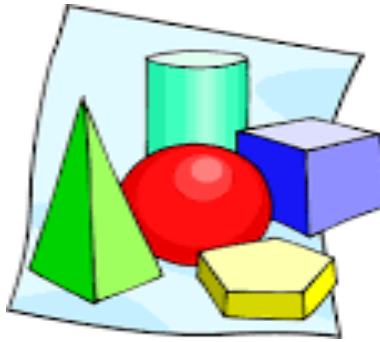


Unit 6 Geometry – Shape and Space
